What to Expect on Your Team Build Day

Type of Construction Work:

No experience is necessary. Trained Habitat leaders will guide volunteers through the day's activities. Flexibility, safety and patience are important on the work-site. Building a home requires teamwork, working alongside future Habitat Tucson homebuyers.

What to Bring/ Wear:

- **Bring your water bottle!** We will provide water to fill them.
- Shoes that are closed-toe and have backs. SLIP-ONS are not permitted.
- Work boots are preferred; thick-soled tennis shoes will be allowed. Please make sure tennis shoes have a solid grip on the sole.
- Please wear "work clothes" or clothes you don't mind getting dirty.
